Pas and Reberger both having massive contributions in building dots and cleaning up the tail towards the back end of the innings, which saw the home side all out for an under par 184. Pick of the bowlers being Lachie Reberger (4-27 off 13), Jack Bulat (2-36 off 12) and Pas (2-33 off 12).

In response, with 35 overs to bat we knew that our work was going to be cut out for us. After losing a couple of early wickets we were in trouble, but recently promoted number 3 batsman Drew Hawley stuck his hand up for a well needed contribution late in the day. Pas then made his way to the crease, playing his strokes as he always does, which in turn has left us in a commanding position at the turn.

We bowled and fielded well to keep Wellers Hill to 45, and were able to finish the game off on a high.

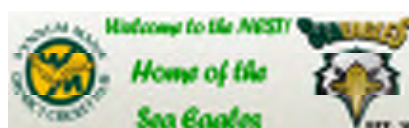
Eighth Grade (B3 Subbies)

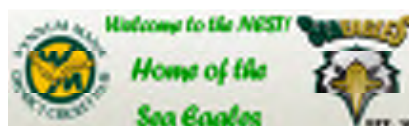

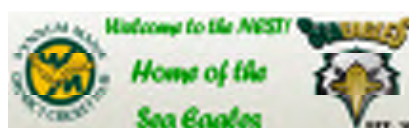

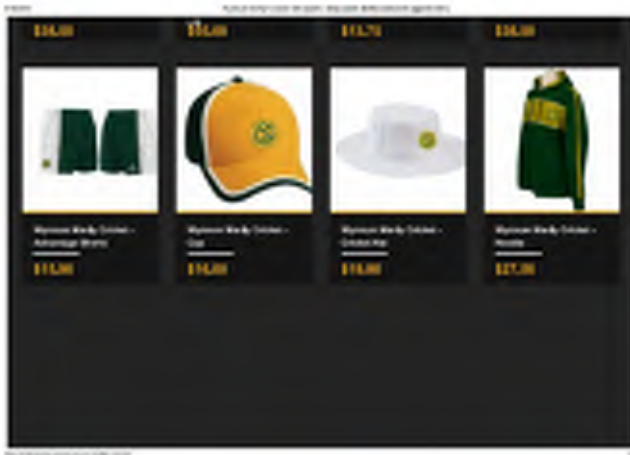
