## Drones Stats!

The current round against Sandgate Redcliffe produced two record breaking performances.

Fifth grade amassed 505 in reply to Sandgate's 202 to record only the fourth instance of an innings total of 500 in the clubs 56 seasons. This innings is only bettered by First grade's semi finals performances against South Brisbane (8/656 to lead to first grade's initial premiership win in March 1981) and Valley (9/555 narrowly losing the final to South Brisbane in March 1986) and Second grade's 7/532 in reply to Northern Suburbs 247 in February 2002.

Hayden Sealey hit 100 falling at 5/350 and with Zach Rollason equalled the partnership of 149 against Northern Suburbs set by Satraj Bamba and David Brook in October 2004. Coming to the wicket at 8/362 Captain Graham Mapri scored his fourth career century (101) after an interval of 12 years and four months partnering 61 with Rollason and 77 with Josh Muller. Taher Kamrudeen was dismissed for 90 narrowly missing what would have been only the second instance of three centuries in an innings.

Fifth grade's previous highest total of 446 secured that grade's first final – against a previously unbeaten Valley team at Peter Easton in March 1993.

Ryan Poole's 134 seventh career ton produced sixth grade's sixth century from six games passing that grade's previous best of four season centuries.

Six centuries for the season equals the performances of second, fourth and under 18 grades with only first grade attaining seven and eight centuries. With three rounds remaining and a chance at the finals this team could equal those performances.

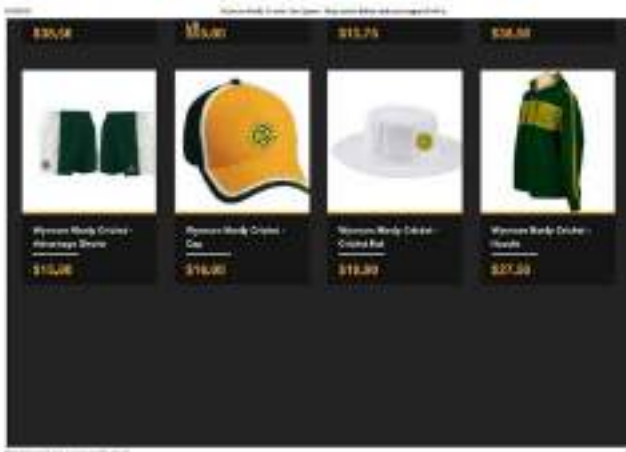
