Welcome to the latest edition of the *Guru Sport Store Match Report*.

Results from the weekend as follows:-

First Grade

First Grade won the toss and opted to bowl first in pursuit of an outright win to push their finals hopes forward.

The wicket was flat and outfield fast but we toiled manfully all day.

Souths batted well and ended the day with a total of 313 with Flo taking 4 fa 81 and Finnis 3 fa 60 being the pick of the bowlers.

A good chase this Saturday should keep us in the hunt for a semi spot with other results hopefully falling our way.

Second Grade

Day 1 at Souths saw Wynnum win the toss (1 from 1 for Steve Graham) and choose to bowl first which seemed like a good decision for the first 2 hours of the bowling innings from having Souths 3/40 and then the wicket flattened out and we ended up bowling Souths out for 340.

Will went out with no fear and smashed every ball coming his way finishing on 49* and Troy on 30 odd. Wynnum finished 0/87 with the man who calls himself "Joe Burns" coming up from 3s to slot straight into batting and Troy to continue to knock off those runs and finish the season well.

Third Grade

Day 1 vs Souths started well for Wynnum. Captain Tait won the toss and elected to bowl. Openers Morrison and Andrew delivered the near perfect start taking three quick wickets and producing multiple chances in the field. The score reading 3-20.

This pressure was well maintained throughout Morrison and Andrew's spells, however, Souths slowly took back control with a long 3rd wicket partnership. Gunning and Freeman worked hard to get past the dull Souths batsmen, bowling lots of dots throughout the middle overs, unfortunately without reward in the form of wickets. Disappointingly, missed chances cost the boys all throughout the day, with several catches going down.

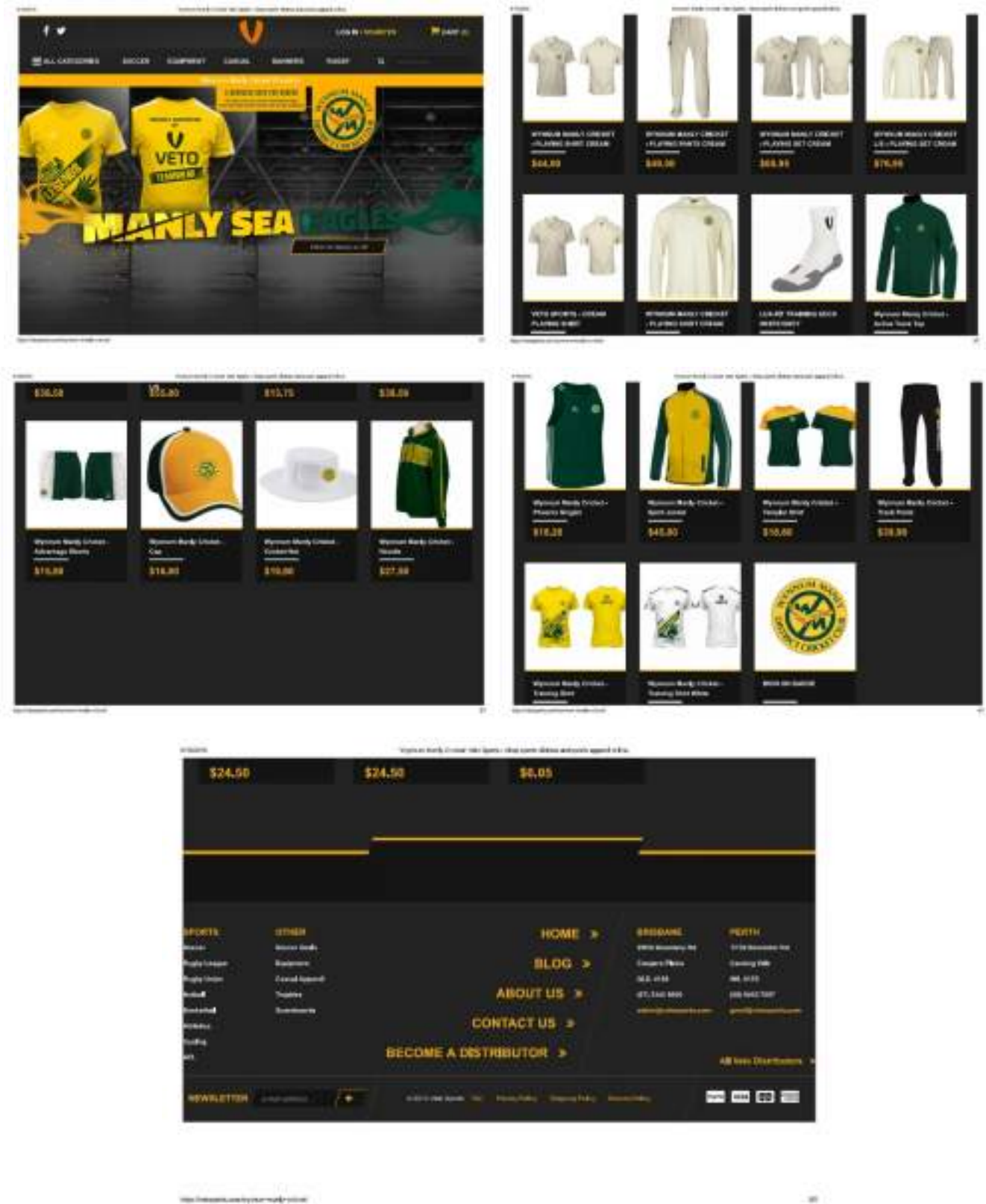
