Welcome to the latest edition of the *Guru Sport Store Match Report*.

Results from the weekend as follows:-

## **First Grade**

First Grade showed up week 2 of our two day game with high hopes chasing over 300 against Souths.

We got off on the right foot with Willy Prowse and the Piece seeing us through to around lunch, which gave the middle order a solid platform to launch from. Trasky added to his already brilliant season scoring another ton (his third this year), showing great grit and determination to fight through some tough spells of consistent bowling.

The middle order all reached double figures but lacked the ability to go on with it. This saw us needing around 30 with two wickets in hand.

## **Second Grade**

The boys rocked up day two chasing 329 already 0/83. The day started well with Troy whacking a boundary first ball.

Unfortunately wickets fell consistently and although there was a little cameo from Lachy at the end it wasn't enough as we fell short by 12. But all in all was a good performance making 316 with only 10 players.

## **Third Grade**

After finishing Day 1 with a score of 7-247, Souths came out to bat on Day 2, with the intent to bat all day. We toiled hard for almost 30 overs, bowling well but without reward, as Souths took advantage of a flat wicket. Souths were eventually bowled out finishing with a score of 337.

With 10 overs to bat before the luncheon interval, we lost one early wicket, but headed into the break still believing we could win it. However a flow of back to back wickets to follow the break had us scrambling at 5-40 and we were forced to try and bat for a draw and keep our finals hopes alive. A hard fought captains knock 62\* from skipper TJ Tait supported well by Sam Bray 38\* in a 107 run partnership, ensured we finished the day at 5-147.

In other Third Grade results, both Uni teams went down, meaning we have a chance of playing finals if we can outright 11th placed Toombul this weekend.

## **Fourth Grade**

Wynnum resumed day 2 1/75 with BJ.Bednarski and L.Monty at the crease in chase of 212 to get first innings.

The chase started well until L.Monty was caught at covers. J.Hainz with Bednarski put a good 52 run partnership before BJ.Bednarski got out for 72.

Only 15-16 overs left in the day we had a bat. Lost a few early on but the pick of the batting was Rhys Marshall's 29 ball 68 and Wynnum finished 4/167 at the end of day 2 of a disappointing first innings result.

Notable performances: R.Marshall 5 wickets & 68, M.Mazzocato 4 wickets, BJ.Bednarski 72 (6 catches).

### **Fifth Grade**

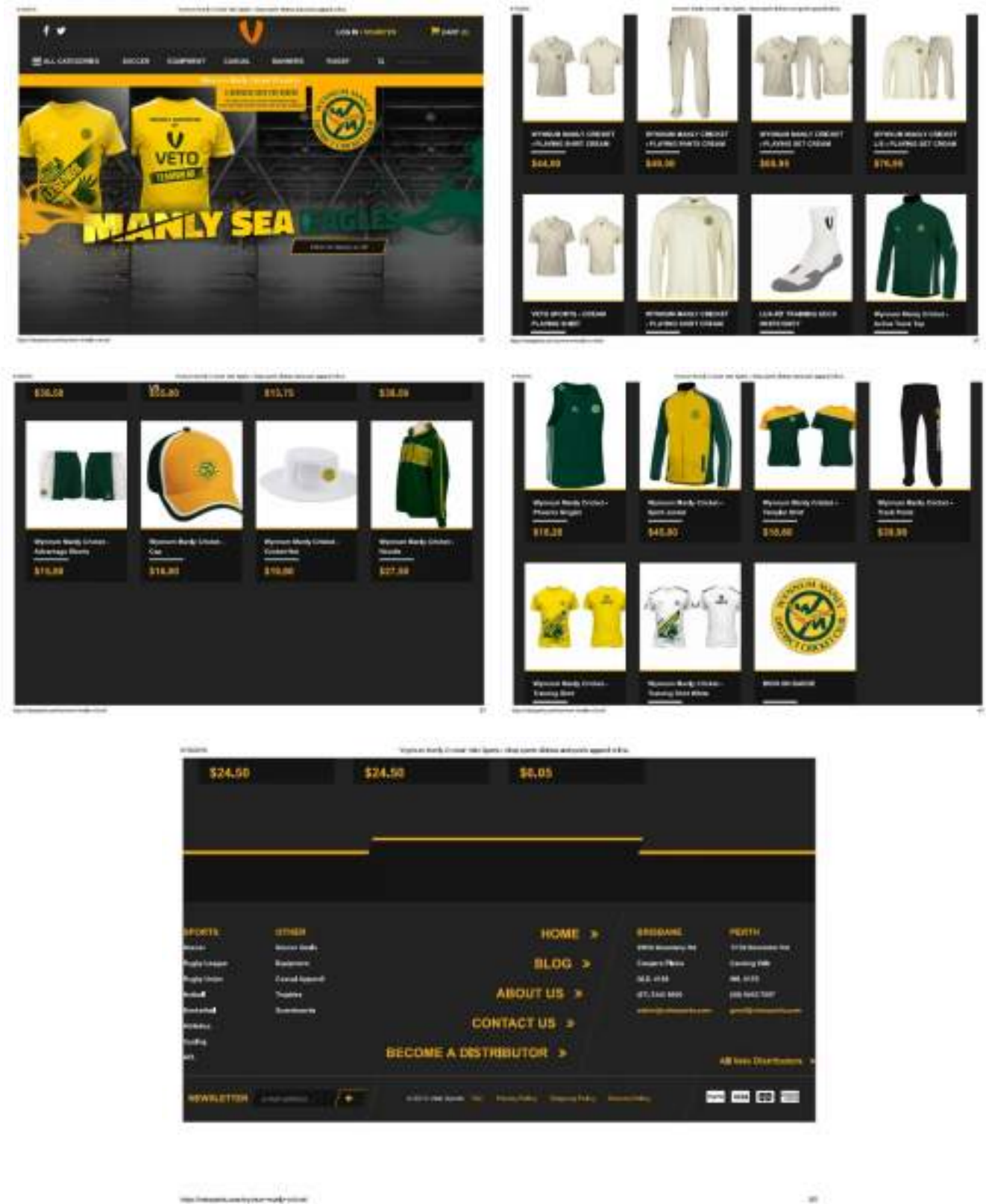
