Results from the weekend as follows:-

## **First Grade**

Rabnott and Flo dominated on Day 1 with Rabs piling on a magnificent 180 to go along with Flo's 96.

A total of 397 and a late wicket for our boys was bookended by Lutzy and Rabs putting on 77 for the last wicket.

A win and a loss for Valleys will see us playing in a semi next weekend.

## **Second Grade**

Day 2 saw Wynnum win the toss and Aggas following on after Steve Grahams 1 from 1 toss record, Wynnum elected to bowl first on a pitch that looked like it had something in it.

Steve Graham and Gunno took the new ball and Steve bowling from one end till lunch couple early wickets put us in the hunt. Even with Steve bouncing someone out, and after Aggas little bowling effort of off spin he calls it getting hit for 3 fours in his over they were looking toset for a big total.

After tea we came out and got some poles ended up bowling them out for 340 odd with Steve bowling 29 overs in the end.

### **Fifth Grade**

A very tough day at the office for 5<sup>th</sup> Grade against a strong Toombul outfit.

We lost the toss and were sent in having to fight hard on a difficult deck. Not many positives with the exception of Kamal carrying his bat through an innings of 111 with 48\*.

We bowled very well and had them 2 fa not many early but a series of dropped catches and dubious decisions caused us to see them at 5 fa 170 at stumps.

### **Sixth Grade**

6s are in a great position heading into the final day of the regular season thanks to a five star performance from next season's first choice fantasy team player James Hanley.

Wynnum won the toss and, confronted with a still soft Dronney wicket, we elected to bowl.

Luke Kingdon took the new rock and bowled quick and most importantly tight from one end whilst Hanley bowling his medium pace seamers from the other end had the ball dancing. Once Hanley broke through the initial stoic Toombul resistance wickets fell regularly. Toombul have very little to play for and then seemed intent on belting every ball as far as possible and as often as possible. Hanley was rested briefly after taking 3 wickets bowling seam up before resuming bowling his quick off breaks (in much the same way as Colin Miller was able to do for the test team a decade ago – very handy).

Toombul were dismissed for 108 with Hanley 7/42 a star.

We batted with the objective of securing first innings points on day one.

Kit "Knight Rider" Freeman took the game away from Toombul from the first over and his 42 was entertaining but also a glimpse of his potential if he can convert these types of starts. His 50 run opening partnership with Josh Treadwell was our highest opening partnership for the season.

Whilst Todd Grooms & Sont were out cheaply, the veteran DK (46) combined with Hanley in a partnership that ensured first innings points for the good guys whilst offering up a master class for our younger aspirational players watching the old warrior sweep and drive us to a strong position.

So, at the end of Day 1 we have a 100 run lead with Hanley 52\* and Big Artie 25\* looking to extend the advantage from the first ball on Saturday before we go hunting our 2nd outright victory of the season.

Kapernick and Farris (turning to spin) were the pick of the bowlers with 2 fa each. At stumps we were 3 fa 78 with Farris 30 odd not out.

We arrived on day 2 to the same flat track and quick outfield. Unfortunately we lost wickets consistently in our chase, eventually being all out for 211. It wasn't without a big 100 from Farris though, putting the Brookfield attack to all parts of Whites Hill.

Brookfield then enforced the follow on, hoping for an outright to push them up the ladder. But we dug in and got ourselves to stumps, 8 down for 210. A change in the order for our second dig saw Gibbo score 40 off 11 balls at number 3, assisted by Gallan with 20 odd at number 5 and Kapernick with 31 in the middle order.

Nice way to end our season with a full day of batting. Just couldn't win a couple of the close ones during the season and we finished in 6th position.

### **Eighth Grade (B3 Subbies)**

## **More Records from Drones!**

The records continue after the first day's play in the latest round against Toombul .

First grade captain Nathan Rabnott produced a personal best of 180 (6 sixes and 21 fours) at LaFrantz Oval attaining the highest individual score in any grade against Toombul and recording the fifth highest first grade individual score. This knock included a fourth wicket partnership of 192 with Jason Floros (96) – falling 13 short of the record 205 and 77 for the last wicket with Chris Lloyd (13\*) - the highest tenth wicket partnership for 33 seasons.

Rabnott took his season aggregate to 1026 runs at 57.00 to join an elite group who have scored 1000 first grade season runs – Mark Gaskell (1103 at 61.27, Mark Tooley (1046 at 55.05) and Justin Poole (1030 at 36.78).

He scored his tenth first grade century to equal Mark Gaskell with only Ryan Broad to have returned more with 14.

The innings total of 397 is the third highest against Toombul behind 3/424 in December 1983 and 398 in October 1987.

In Sunday's fifth grade game at LaFrantz Oval against Toombul Kamal Laher joined a rare group of four who have carried the bat, scoring 46 of his team's 111 in the only instance in fifth grade.

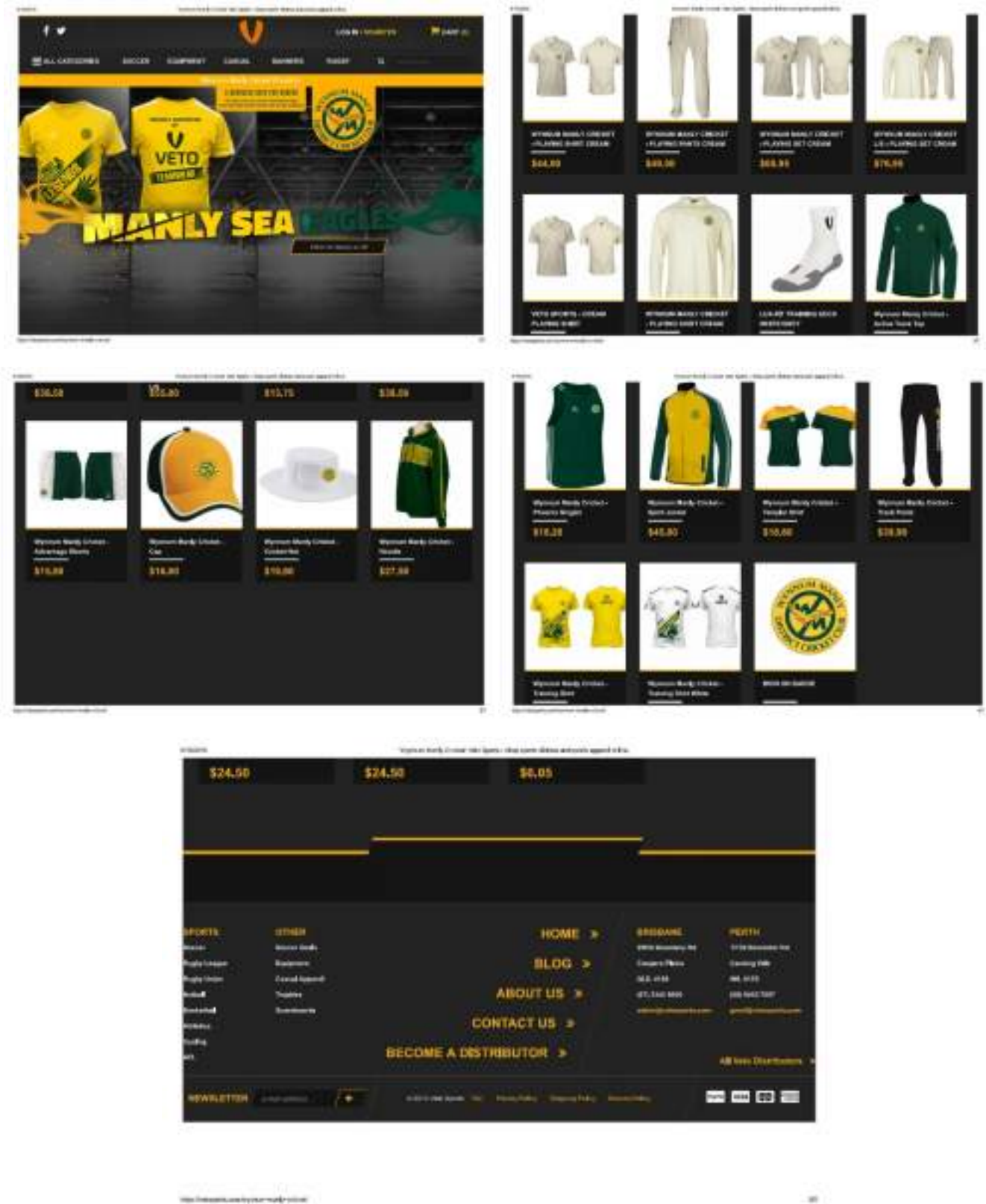
