Results from the weekend as follows:-

## **First Grade**

## **Second Grade**

## **Third Grade**

Saturday saw the boys wrap up the season in the best possible way, dismantling Toombul in convincing fashion to produce an outright win.

Morrison and Harvey started off the day with an attacking mentality, trying to put the bowlers in with a good chance of bowling out Toombul in a timely manner. Initially the plan was to bat for a maximum of 15 overs, but with these 2 at the crease the plan went out the window as we witnessed some of the best batting of the season. Harvey played a class innings, rotating the strike with ease whilst cementing himself as the core of the partnership. Morrison came out in a mood to score runs and he didn't disappoint, reminding everyone at the club of his all-round ability. These two continued for 48 overs, both notching up centuries (Harvey 101, Morrison 102), leaving the team total at 4/246, a lead of 119 when Tjaard decided to declare.

The lads came out after the declaration eager to get stuck in, and despite a stubborn Toombul opening partnership, we got a crucial breakthrough after 13 overs thanks to a spell of pressure bowling from Bray. We knew that Toombul had a weak middle order and went after them hard, providing lots of energy in the field and with the ball. Andrews, Runday and Tait proceeded to build pressure whilst the boys in the field backed them up sensationally. It was clear that the Toombul batsmen felt swamped by our presence as a team, and struggled to get starts (only 2 of the 11-batsmen scoring over 10 runs). Andrew finished the day with 2 wickets, Bray with 1, Runday with 2 and Tait with an impressive 4-13 off 7.

Toombul finished with a lead of 28, with a minimum of 6 overs to be bowled. Tait and Morrison opened and finished the job quickly, scoring the runs in 3 overs, Tait with 15 and Morrison with 14.

Mixed with some beautiful running between wickets, communication and great shots the boys put on a 129 run partnership to go past Toombul's score. Unfortunately BJ.Bednarski got out just after passing their score and was on track to post his first ton for the club in his 4th match but wasn't the case. In at 6 was D.Foxe who continued to support a big hitting R.Marshall. D.Foxe got out after a nice little supporting role after 10 overs. At this stage R.Marshall was heading towards his first ton for the club and already passed his highest score of 68. In at 7 was the skipper N.Bowtell having the old man's disease of gout the poor bloke, so running so much wasn't an option for the skipper. He came in and hit some nice shots all over the park for a quick little cameo while helping R.Marshall getting his maiden 100 for the club whilst getting a roar of congratulations from the sidelines. Well done.

At this stage Wynnum were heading fast towards 300, R.Marshall's innings came to an end at 112 after the skipper went. The tail wagged further thanks to some big shots from B.Klemm, M.Mazzacato and even S.MacDowell who would you believe, hit a big six at cow off a spinner.

Wynnum finished with 333 all out after 71.3 overs. With about 40 odd minutes of play left, Toombul decided to have a little bit of a hit with the bat. Chance of an outright for Wynnum would have needed a miracle but boys nabbed a few wickets with the ball with wickets to R.Marshall and B.Klemm and Toombul ended with 3/40 after 8 overs with Wynnum winning first innings. A great performance from the boys and just missing out on finals.

He & Reid "Artie" Graham continued briefly where they left off and put on 70 before Artie took his own place in Wynnum history by becoming the first Sea Eagle to be dismissed by a female player in Wynnum grade history (this may not actually be a fact BTW but it certainly got some mileage on the day) – with the rise of the Women's game he won't be the last.

Ash Robinson, fresh from his Adelle experience was good enough to drop into the batting order and say 'Hello'. A careful 4 runs off 26 balls was somewhat out of character and not quite what we were looking for. With the declaration imminent he then launched, hitting 34 runs off 20 balls – telling runs in the end.

Hanley at the other end was doing it easily until he tried to drive with the toe of his bat and holed out to cover for a beautiful 87. An opportunity missed. We closed up at 8/315.

We then fielded. Toombul showed much more character this innings. Their first pole fell to a cracking short leg catch to Sub fieldsmen Mull that had even the dismissed batsmen clapping. Three quick poles and Toombul were 4/55. A 109 run partnership then ensued that sapped the life out of our boys helped along by a dropped catch or two. The outright and 1st place on the ladder was slipping away along with the day.

We got lucky in the end to break the partnership. The batsmen attempted a quick single however the non-striker tried to run through our bowler Artie (3/21) (who was attempting to field the ball) and came off 2nd best. His mate kept running and we executed a simple run-out. From 5/164, Toombul were all out for 199 with Hanley (5/76) tidying up the tail bowling offies and in doing so completing a 12 wicket haul for the match. His 24 wickets at 7.96 in just 3 games has come at the right time to enable our established quicks some recovery time after a long season leading into the finals. Team thanks in particular to Doc Leggatt and Todd Grooms for helping out over the last 8 weeks and Mull for fielding again when we were short.

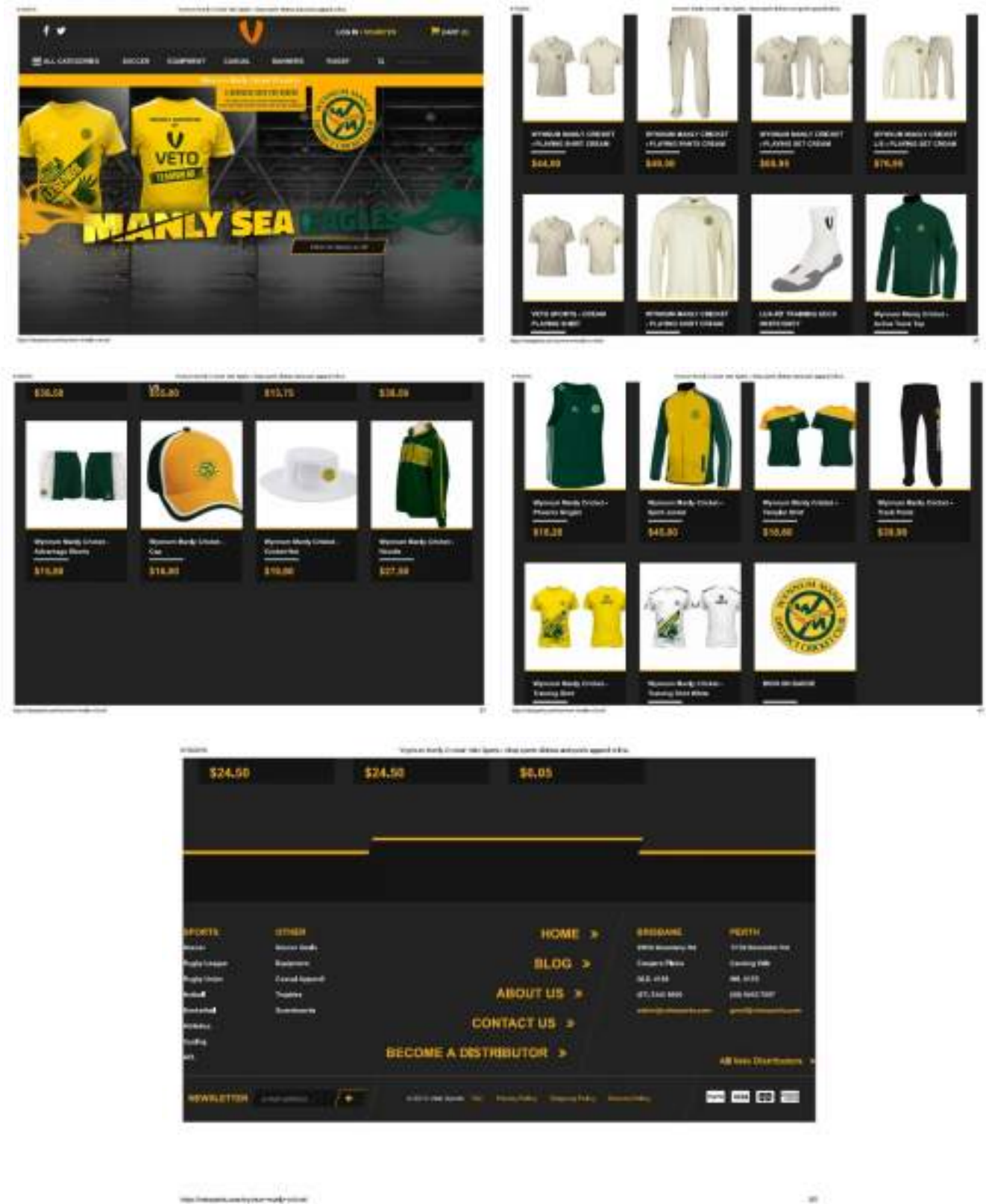
