Under clear skies, Wynnum took on Redlands at Bill Albury on Saturday. We won the toss and elected to bat on a flat, dry deck that we thought might turn.

We have struggled all season to get our top order to fire and semi-final day 1 was no different.

As expected, Redlands bowled a tight line and we once again struggled to see off the new rock or progress the scoreboard. Freeman (11) was unusually subdued before being adjudged LBW. Treadwell (5) chased a wide one and edged to slips giving the Redlands attack a sniff. Murphy Hill (1) fell LBW shortly afterwards and we were under the pump at 3/29.

Mackenzie Hill and Dimple Cheema (4) then played cautiously for a critical 67 run partnership before Hill (45) fell LBW. Cheema's LBW was the 3rd in the match but at 5/131 we were still reasonably expecting a score beyond 250 on a true deck. Unfortunately Ryan Poole (25) then failed to see the man at deep long on and his dismissal signalled a run of poor shot selection. A short time later we were all out for 164 having lost 6/33. Robinson (4), Reid Graham (1), Reggie (0) and Kingdon (1) all falling to ambitious shot selection (except Reggie) leaving Sont (19*) to watch from the other end. The Redlands spectators were in good voice..

Redlands rightly went into bat with confidence though they allowed themselves to bog down for long periods which was surprising given weather forecasts for the weekend. Kingdon and Robinson held excellent bowling lines and worked hard for the initial breakthrough which came when Robinson found a way through to hit the stumps after Redlands had crawled to 15. At stumps on Day 1 Redlands were 1/47 off 21 overs and probably felt that they had the upper hand.

It rained heavily overnight.

Weather reports and pictures at 6am from our man Cheema who slept at the ground showed the fury of mother-nature. Cheema went home to bed thinking the day was cooked and was stunned when called to the ground a few hours later.

The rest of us arrived to an Albury Oval with a series of duck ponds spread across it at 10:30am. Groundsman Bowtell made our two super soppers available and both teams worked tirelessly non-stop for almost 5 hours to recover the ground and our 1st Grade boys dropped in to wish their club mates well.

Play resumed at 4:20pm on Sunday after numerous field inspections by the match officials.

Redlands had the opportunity to attack the scoreboard and steal the match but excellent bowling from Kingdon and Robinson backed by a very pumped fielding unit built enormous pressure on the established batting pair who were simply unable to tick the scoreboard along.

After an excellent spell, Kingdon (0/23 off 12) was replaced by big Reid "Artie" Graham at the Southern end and it was Artie's 4 overs that effectively handed the victory if not the win to the Sea Eagles.

Artie's slower pace was too much for the constrained Redlands batsmen to resist as they immediately sort to launch an assault at the target as clouds started to build to the east. A smart catch in the covers by Kingdon off Artie's first over popped the proverbial pressure cork.

This 1st wicket was followed next ball by a brilliant catch at the stumps by keeper Poole again off Artie. The Wynnum skipper then took a regulation (...for Steve Smith maybe) 1st slip catch again off Artie before Scott Reberger made it 4 poles for Artie in 4 overs when he took a neat catch in at short cover. By this stage, Pandemonium had erupted on the oval as the Redlands bats became hesitant and the throng of loyal Tigers supporters became very quiet indeed.

In the end it was not Artie (4/7 off 4) or Ash 2/36 off 13 or the efforts of the entire fielding unit but rather rain that snuffed out any receding hope Redlands may have had for an unlikely tail wag to victory. Having finished the regular season in 1st place our boys were happy to accept the draw as their gateway to the final.

The lads lingered for a long time in the players room afterwards enjoying the victory. It's a terrific time to be playing cricket after a long, hot season. We toasted our 5th grade mates who battled valiantly against Toombul only to be denied by the same weather that smoothed our own passage to the final - and we let Poole take the lead as we sung the club song with gusto.
